### RULES OF THE ROAD, PLEASE READ

Bicyclists must obey ALL California Vehicle Code laws, and are subject to the same rights-of-way as cars. Bicyclists have an equal right to the road, but please be courteous.

- 1. Wear your helmet at all times while riding. It is for your safety!!
- 2. Obey all signal lights and stop at all stop signs. You may be ticketed if you don't comply!!
- 3. Ride single file on all roads.
- 4. Use hand signals when turning or stopping. Point out road hazards to others.
- 5. Pass other cyclists or pedestrians on the left with a friendly "Hello", or "On your left".
- 6. Wave vigorously to attract a sag wagon's attention, if needed. Be visible!

You must check in at the end of the ride. Notify a rest stop official or sag driver if you leave the tour.
