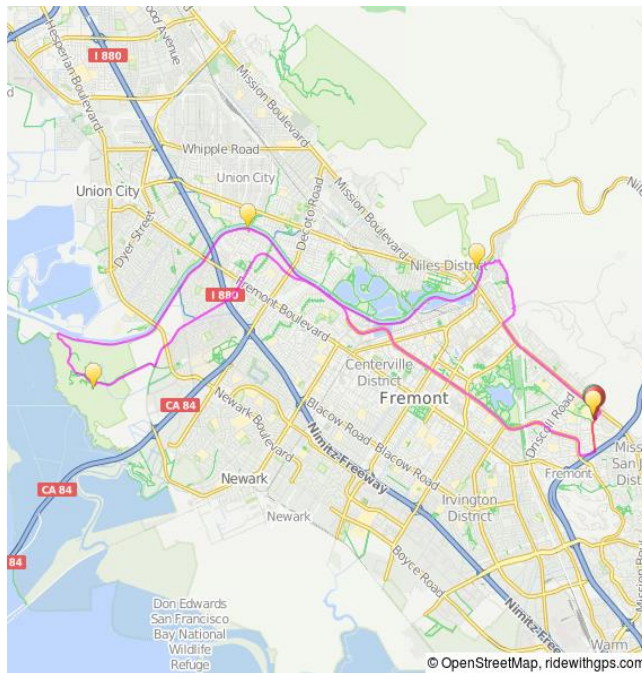

RULES OF THE ROAD, PLEASE READ

Bicyclists must obey ALL California Vehicle Code laws, and are subject to the same rights-of-way as cars. Bicyclists have an equal right to the road, but please be courteous.

1. Wear your helmet at all times while riding. It is for your safety!!
2. Obey all signal lights and stop at all stop signs. You may be ticketed if you don't comply!!
3. Ride single file on all roads.
4. Use hand signals when turning or stopping. Point out road hazards to others.
5. Pass other cyclists or pedestrians on the left with a friendly "Hello", or "On your left".
6. Wave vigorously to attract a sag wagon's attention, if needed. Be visible!
