

Use of Calaveras looking good for Primavera Century

The San Francisco Public Utility Commission (SFPUC) and Alameda County have agreed to open Calaveras Road exclusively for the Primavera Century, subject to additional insurance, permits and other conditions. We are thrilled to be able to return to the iconic Calaveras Road, and are in the process of meeting the conditions set by the SFPUC and Alameda County.

Calaveras Road will not be open to the general public at all, until later in the year. During the Primavera Century, one of the conditions is to have a Sheriff checkpoint at each end of the segment, and only riders with Primavera bike numbers will be allowed through.

For those who were waiting to register until hearing about the status of Calaveras Road, you should sign up quickly, as there are limited number of spaces remaining. For those who can't make the ride, there are no refunds or roll-overs, but we do have a free transfer system. If you do not know someone looking to ride, Craigslist and our Facebook page are popular sites. Please sell your registration for \$80 or less. No scalping!
