11.7	S	Continue past gate onto Bayview Trail
12.5	R	Connector to Alameda Creek Trail Caution: Steep downhill
12.5	R or L	Turn right to continue 25 mile route. Turn left to ride 2 extra miles to the end of the trail for a good view of the bay and, on a clear day, San Francisco
16.5	R	Rest Stop - Beard Staging Area Closes @ 3:00 pm 
16.6	R	Continue on Alameda Creek Trail (to end)

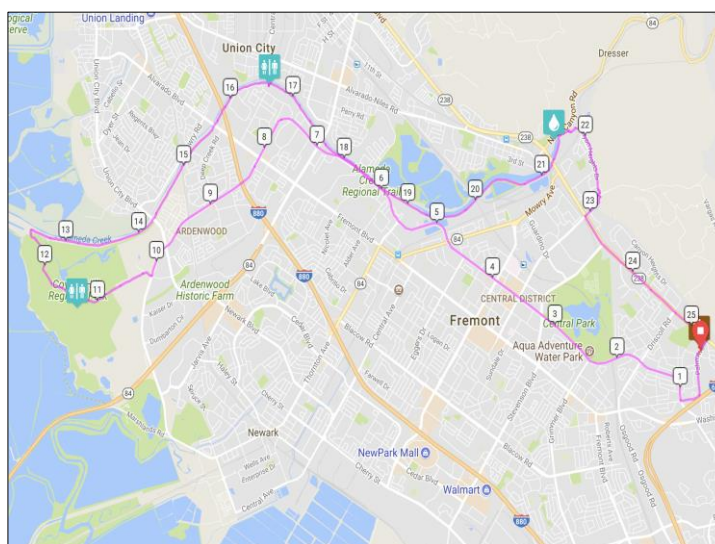

Rules of the ride

Bicyclists must obey all California Vehicle Code laws and are subject to the same rights and responsibilities as other vehicles.

- Wear your helmet at all times while riding.
- Obey all signal lights and stop signs.
- Ride single file on all roads.
- Use hand signals when turning or stopping.
- Point or call out hazards to others.
- Call out when passing other riders or pedestrians, and pass only on the left.
- If you need to stop a SAG vehicle, wave vigorously to attract the occupant's attention.

Please check in with the organizers at the end of the ride. Notify a rest stop official or SAG driver if you plan to leave the ride.
